2018-19	1. Suggestions were made by the employees of the college to renovate the college quarters.	1. The college quarters meant for the faculty members (teaching) were renovated with tile flooring, concealed wiring and distempering both the inner and outer walls. (It was done by the R & B on request over phone by the Principal of the college).
2019-20	1. The proposal was given by the students for beautification of college garden. 2. Suggestions in alumni meeting regarding installation of statue of Lord Ganesh.	1. The principal of the college arranged necessary fund for cleaning of the garden and beautification of the same. 2. The alumni association took the initiative and installed the statue of Lord Ganesh at the entrance.
2020-21	1. Suggestion was made by the employer to take classes in online mode during the pandemic. 2. The employees of the college proposed, particularly the teaching staff, to conduct webinars. 3. It was proposed by the students to purchase more number of books as per CBCS syllabus. 4. The students proposed for discussion of the performance of the students in projects and assignments.	1. During the pandemic online classes were taken by teacher through Zoom and Google meet. 2. The college holds the distinction of organizing more than 50 (fifty) webinars during the period. 3. Action was taken by the authority and new books were purchased for the library. 4. One HOD meeting was held regarding the suggestions of the students and the HODs were directed to take up the issue with the teachers of the department for greater interests of the students.
2021-22	1. Both the employee and the final year students proposed for preparation of the academic calendar well in advance for smooth conduct of curricular & co-curricular activities.	1. The academic calendar was prepared well in advance in order to apprise the students of the forthcoming examinations.

It was proposed by the students and the parents to open new courses both in PG and UG level due to high demand of the students as it is the only Government College of the locality. 2. The alumni and the students raised concern over continuous theft from college campus. 3. It was proposed by the students for installation of new LAN connection in the college in place of outdated one. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The college administration took initiatives for opening of new UG and PG course form the next academic session. 2. The college administration decided for installation of CCTV camera system, particularly in and around the smart rooms, computer labs, and practical labs of science departments after the construction work is over. It was also decided to pursue the R&B department for construction of the boundary wall. 3. It was decided to write a letter to the Government of Odisha for installation of New LAN connection with wi-fi for smooth conduct of smart classes, online searching of study materials and effective use of e-resources sites given by the Government of Odisha.
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
