Introduction


Major Objective of Gender Audit





Gender sensitization initiatives inside the campus

College has formed various committees such as – Anti- ragging committee, internal complaint and sexual harassment prevention committee and moreover the college is providing adequate facilities to girl students and female staff members to maintain gender equality.

The following initiatives have been undertaken by the college for the convenience of girl students and female teachers.

- 1. Study Room: Independent study room has been provided by the college library for girl students.
- 2. Girls common room: A separate common room with lavatory and Urinals facilities have been provided to the girl students within the college building for their convenience.
- 3. Girls washroom: There are 8 separate wash-room for girls students in different places of the college which are properly maintained from time to time.
- 4. Drinking water: Water coolers and water purifiers have been installed for both boys and girls students in different places of the college.
- 5. College Canteen: There is a separate section inside the canteen to cater to the needs of girl students.

Different committees for girls and boys in the college.

- a) Anti-ragging committee:- In order to prevent ragging, in any form inside the college campus, an anti-ragging committee has been formed. It works after to prevent ragging inside the college campus and in different hostels. The committee has both male and female members. The committee members are Dr. T.N.P pati, Dr. Sradhanjali Sahoo, Dr. D Singh, Dr. A.P. Mishra. (Order No. 1153, 08/11/2021)
- b) Discipline committee: The college has a discipline committee with male and female members for maintenance of discipline inside the college campus and also in different hostels and canteen. The principal is the chairperson of the said committee.
- c) Women's forum:- The empowerment of women and gender equality are sine-qua-non for the upliftment of the girl students. As such the college has a women forum with both teaching and non-teaching staff members of the college to create a gender equality committee within the campus as well as in the society. It has been organizing different programs for sensitizing girl students.
- d) Internal Complains Committee:- There is an internal complain committee in the college consists of both male and female teachers to respond to the complains made by the students on different issues and to provide adequate solutions to the complains made.
- e) Equal Opportunities Cell:- For the overall development of personality of the students adequate opportunities in different spheres of education is a must. Considering the above facts the college has an equal opportunities cell to ensure that both boys and girl students are getting adequate opportunities for their overall development.
